### **#LetTheMusicPlay in 2020 at Eden Park - have your say on concerts!**

Last December Eden Park announced that it would lodge a publicly notified application to stage up to six concerts a year and now's your chance to use your voice.

Submissions are now open on [Auckland Council's website](#), until 5pm on 3 April. You can read today's media release [here](#).

Under Auckland Council's Unitary Plan, the stadium can apply to stage up to six shows annually each as a discretionary activity. However experience has shown that applying for individual resource consents for each show is a practicably unattainable proposition for both the stadium and music promoters.

Eden Park continues to engage with the local community, including the Community Liaison Group, and further consultation will be undertaken in the coming weeks to understand all views on the proposal. In line with the [final food truck event](#) of the series, next Wednesday 11 March from 7-8pm, we're hosting an information evening for you to get a clearer understanding of the application, the stadium's direction as well as a chance to provide feedback and speak directly with our team. ### **Acoustic Barrier**

We are pleased to advise that Eden Park is installing an acoustic barrier at the eastern end of the stadium, as required by the previous consent from Auckland Council for the venue's

RWC2011 redevelopment, and will do so regardless of the outcome of the consent application. The barrier will include a large digital screen which will substantially enhance the fan experience at both sporting fixtures and concerts.
