### **Mitre 10 Cup Auckland v Manawatu**

Auckland face Manawatu this Sunday at 2.05pm however due to a limit on patron numbers there are no public sales for this match and no Traffic Management Plan or ROP in place. As an event facility, the stadium can operate at Alert Level 2 whilst observing all required COVID-19 processes and restrictions including extremely limited attendees. Patrons will be hosted in pods of 100 and they must enter through assigned gates, sign in upon entry, utilise designated facilities and practise physical distancing. Ongoing measures are also in place including sanitiser stations, hygiene promotion signage and additional cleaning of frequently touched surfaces. We look forward to welcoming you back when live sport and entertainment returns more consistently when safe and possible!

### **Resource Consent Hearing**

Thank you to everyone who had their say in the resource consent submission period which closed earlier this year. The hearing for our application to host up to six concerts per year has been scheduled for 2-6 November in front of a panel of independent commissioners.

You may be aware that every submitter has the opportunity to attend the hearing and further convey their thoughts. If you submitted, you should have heard from Auckland Council asking you to confirm your interest, or not, in appearing at the hearing. It isn't an adversarial process but rather a chance for people to share their opinions one-on-one with the commissioners who want to ensure everyone's views are expressed and the hearing is comprehensive.

We encourage you to consider participating to ensure that a fair representation of the community's collective voice is heard.
