

In celebration of 125 years since women were granted the right to vote, we have commissioned a local artist to install a mural at Eden Park. Next Wednesday 19th September we will be unveiling it along with illuminating our stadium lights purple for the evening.

The permanent mural follows a number of other art installations at Eden Park to ensure the stadium is utilised for not only cricket and rugby but all other recreational, musical and cultural events for the benefit of the public of the region.
