Our outer oval was flooded again during last night's rain, but we know from experience that 24 hours can make a massive difference. By Sunday morning, there was little evidence anymore of the flooding we saw on Saturday.

In consultation with engineers and experts, our turf and facilities teams are currently working on draining the field, and our team is now 100% focussed on delivering the stadium's upcoming event calendar. Fortunately, we can now see some sunshine, which hopefully signals the end of the extreme weather.

To all of our community who have been impacted by the weather, our thoughts are with you.

We know firsthand how tough it can be to deal with the aftermath of flooding. Eden Park is currently exploring ways we can support members of our community who have been affected by the weather.

We also want to reassure you that water being drained from the Park is not having any impact on residential areas.
