
ALL BLACKS VENGLAND SATURDAY 13 JULY 2024 | GATES OPEN: 5.00PM

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parking Restrictions [4.00pm - 10.30pm]:

A number of roads surrounding Eden Park, including those within the resident-only parking scheme, are reserved for traffic management. These roads are identified on the map and will be clearly signposted on event day.

Parking restrictions will be enforced by Auckland Transport, with tow trucks operating between 4.00pm and 10.30pm. Parking is available in streets not within the resident parking zone or the traffic management plan.

Managed Access and Road Closures [4.00pm - 10.30pm]:

Road closures will be in place from 4.00pm on the day of the event through to 10.30pm. Local residents and their visitors will have access through these road closures at all times, unless it is unsafe to do so. For the best way to access your street, please refer to the TMP map.

ROAD CLOSURES (8.00PM - 10.30PM):

Road closure post event from 8.00pm onwards.

Please note, only registered vehicles with a valid parking permit will be permitted to park on the street, all other vehicles will need to be parked off-street. Refer to the Resident-Only Parking Scheme below.

Resident-Only Parking (ROP) Scheme [4.00pm - 10.30pm]:

The ROP scheme is in place for residents who require on-street parking during an event. Between 4.00pm and 10.30pm on the day of the event, only registered vehicles with a valid parking permit (either registered digitally with AT or displaying a physical parking permit) can park on the streets in the areas identified on the TMP map.

Please note, even with a valid parking permit, you may be towed if you choose to park in restricted areas identified as mobility parking, no parking, authorised parking and coach parking zones. Please refer to the TMP map for these areas. How to get a parking permit:

- **Permanent Parking Permit:** Residents can apply for a permanent parking permit from Auckland Transport: https://at.govt.nz/driving-parking/parking-permits/resident-parking-permits-coupons/eden-park-parking-permits
- Temporary Parking Permit: if you require a temporary parking permit, these can be collected from Eden Park Reception (Gate G) Monday – Friday 8am – 5pm or on event day. Please note you will need to bring proof of your address dated within the last two months.

Please keep your parking permit in your vehicle to avoid being ticketed or towed.

Audio Testing:

Closed sound checks are scheduled to occur on event day. Once the times are confirmed we will update the FAQs on the All Blacks v England event page on our website. Sound engineers will be on site on event day to ensure noise remains within the required levels.

Toilets & Rubbish Bins:

Additional rubbish bins and temporary toilet facilities will be placed within the stadium precinct. Clean up of the area will be undertaken at the conclusion of the event.
