

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parking Restrictions [3.00pm - midnight]:

The streets surrounding Eden Park will be reserved for resident-only-parking and for vehicles displaying an approved visitor parking pass (please see below for more information). These roads are identified on the map and are clearly signposted on event day.

The parking restrictions will be enforced by Auckland Transport, with tow trucks operating between 4.00pm and midnight. Please call our hotline on (09) 815 4820 if you have any concerns.

Parking is available in streets that are not within the resident-only-parking area.

Managed Access [4.00pm - midnight]:

To ensure our residents and their visitors are not inconvenienced by the parking restrictions or road closures, managed access points will be in place from 4.00pm on the day of the event through to midnight.

Local residents and their visitors will have access through these managed access points at all times, unless it is unsafe to do so. We appreciate that with a number of roads surrounding the stadium closed to traffic, your usual route could be impacted. To find the best way to access your street before, during or after an event, please refer to the Access Points 1 – 6 on the map on page 1.

Resident-Only Parking (ROP) Scheme [3.00pm - midnight]:

The resident-only-parking (ROP) scheme is in place for residents who require on-street parking before, during, and after an event.

Between 3.00pm and midnight on the day of the event, only vehicles with a valid parking permit (either registered digitally with AT or displaying a physical residents parking permit or approved visitor pass) are able to park on the streets in the areas identified on the map on Page 1.

Please note, even with a valid resident-only parking permit or approved visitor pass, you may be towed if you choose to park in areas that are identified as no parking, mobility parking, or authorised parking.

Please refer to the TMP map for these areas.

How to get a parking permit:

- **Permanent Residents-only Parking Permit:** Residents can apply for a permanent parking permit from Auckland Transport using this link: https://at.govt.nz/driving-parking/parking-permits/resident-parking-permits-coupons/eden-park-parking-permits
- Visitor Parking Pass: if you have guests while we have an event on, they will require a temporary visitor-parking permit to park on the street. These can be collected from Eden Park Reception (Gate G) Monday Friday 8am 5pm or on an event day. These permits must be displayed in the vehicle. Please note you will need to bring proof of your address dated within the last two months.

If you have a physical parking permit please ensure it is visible in your vehicle to avoid being ticketed or towed.

Audio Testing:

Closed sound checks are scheduled to occur on event day. Once the times are confirmed we will update the FAQs on the Coldplay event page on our website. Sound engineers will be on site on event day to ensure noise remains within the required levels.

Toilets & Rubbish Bins:

Additional rubbish bins and temporary toilet facilities will be placed within the stadium precinct. Clean up of the area will be undertaken during the show and the following morning..

Please note, changes to the Traffic Management Plan may be required on event day for public safety reasons.
