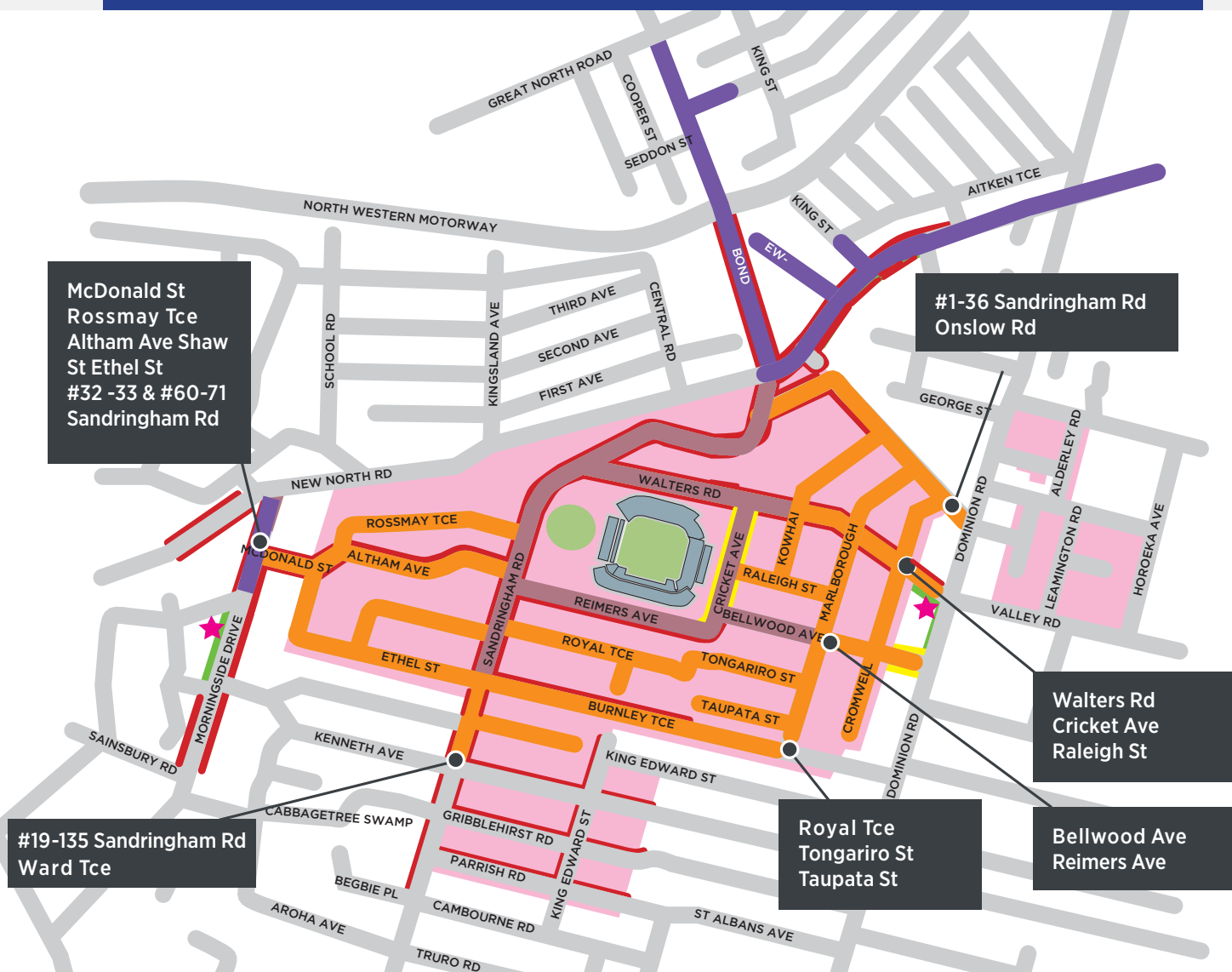

ROAD CLOSURES & ACCESS

4pm – 12am

To ensure everyone's safety and smooth traffic flow, several roads surrounding Eden Park will be temporarily closed on the day of the event.

- Local residents and their visitors will still have access through these closures at all times.
- Short delays may occur during peak arrival and departure periods. We appreciate your patience as we help fans arrive and leave the concert safely.
- Only registered vehicles with a valid parking permit will be permitted to park on these roads unless a full parking restriction is in place (see below). All other vehicles should be parked off-street.

EVENT PARKING RESTRICTIONS

4pm – 12am

To accommodate concert traffic, mobility parking, emergency access and authorised vehicles, parking restrictions will apply on a number of nearby streets.

- Restricted streets are shown on the map and will be clearly signposted on event day.
- For questions or to report parking concerns, please contact Auckland Transport (AT) on (09) 355 3553. AT will be monitoring and enforcing parking restrictions throughout the event.

RESIDENT ONLY PARKING (ROP) SCHEME

Residents who need to park on-street during an event can apply for a Residents Only Parking (ROP) Permit.

- Only registered vehicles with a valid parking permit (either registered digitally with AT or displaying a parking permit) can park on the streets in the ROP area.
- Vehicles must still comply with any temporary parking restrictions.

How to get a parking permit

- Permanent parking permit: apply through Auckland Transport: at.govt.nz/
- Temporary parking permit: collect from our Gate G reception Monday to Friday between 8am and 5pm. Please bring proof of your address dated within the last two months.

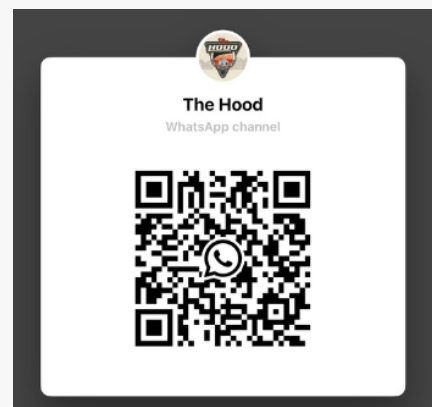
AUDIO TESTING

Closed sound checks are scheduled to occur in the days leading up to the event. Confirmed times will be published on the Eden Park website and via The Hood WhatsApp Channel.

Sound engineers will be on site on event day and during the concert to monitor noise levels.

TOILETS & RUBBISH BINS

Additional rubbish bins and temporary toilet facilities will be placed around the stadium precinct. Our cleaning team will monitor the area throughout the event and complete a full clean the following morning.
