

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parking Restrictions [6.00am - 9.00pm]:

A number of roads surrounding Eden Park, including those within the resident-only parking scheme, are reserved for traffic management. These roads are identified on the map and will be clearly signposted on event day.

Parking restrictions will be enforced by Auckland Transport, with tow trucks operating between 6.00am and 9.00pm. Parking is available in streets not within the resident parking zone or the traffic management plan.

Managed Access [6.00am - 9.00pm]:

Managed Access will be in place from 6.00am on the day of the event through to 9.00pm. Local residents and their visitors will have access through these road closures at all times, unless it is unsafe to do so. For the best way to access your street, please refer to the Access Points on the map on page 1.

Resident-Only Parking (ROP) Scheme [6.00am - 9.00pm]:

The ROP scheme is in place for residents who require on-street parking during an event. Between 6.00am and 9.00pm on the day of the event, only registered vehicles with a valid parking permit (either registered digitally with AT or displaying a physical parking permit) can park on the streets in the areas identified on the TMP map.

Please note, even with a valid parking permit, you may be towed if you choose to park in restricted areas identified as mobility parking, no parking, authorised parking and coach parking zones. Please refer to the TMP map for these areas. How to get a parking permit:

- Permanent Parking Permit: Residents can apply for a permanent parking permit from Auckland Transport: https://at.govt.nz/driving-parking/parking-permits/resident-parking-permits-coupons/eden-park-parking-permits
- **Temporary Parking Permit:** if you require a temporary parking permit, these can be collected from Eden Park Reception (Gate G) Monday Friday 8am 5pm or on event day. Please note you will need to bring proof of your address dated within the last two months.

Please keep your parking permit in your vehicle to avoid being ticketed or towed.

Please note, changes to the Traffic Management Plan may be required on event day for public safety reasons.
